

NEWLY DISCOVERED 2012 OLYMPIC 'COIL' PRINTING



We have recently discovered 6 of the (29) Olympic stamps which were produced in coils (they were printed in sheetlets of 6 in a coil of 1000) to facilitate First Day Cover production by the Philatelic Bureau. This is a completely different printing which has NO PHOSPHOR bars visual on the front of the stamp. The 6 stamps are as follows:
