These newspapers were mailed to Messrs. Brown Brothers & Co., a firm of Investment Bankers in New York. Unusually 3 of the same paper were mailed from the port of Liverpool to New York and there the very first Great Britain 3d Queen Victoria stamp was instead in 1862.
