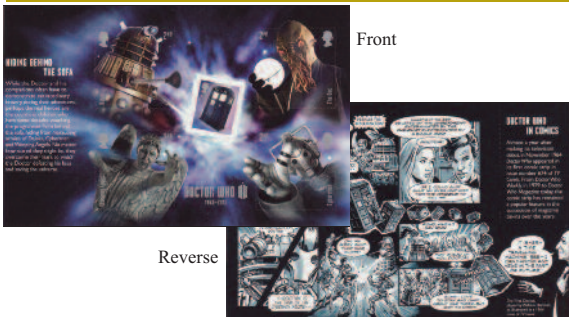

## MOUNTBATTEN AUTOGRAPHS - HAMPSHIRE'S SOCIETY WEDDING

## OWN A HISTORICAL SIGNATURE "Charles Dickens"

We have acquired a pair of signed mailing envelopes written by Charles Dickens, the famous English Author in his own hand. Posted from London W.C. with a Plate 103 Queen Victoria 1d Red, addressed to Miss Georgina Hogarth (his wife's younger sister who died at 18). One is dated 21st December 1865 and the other 2nd July 1867, which has the "C.D. oval shaped ornament" Personal Seal on the reverse flap. These covers were found in the USA in a mixed box of 1d Red Covers in the 1960's and reported in Linn's Weekly in June 1970 (copy of article included).
