The original and 1st GB self-adhesives were, in fact, issued in 1974 to commemorate the 10th anniversary of the world's 1st self-adhesives which were produced by Sierra Leone, despite claims by the Royal Mail that their recent experimental trial period booklet contained the first G.B. self-adhesive stamp - it is, of course, the 1st NVI G.B. self-adhesive!

This new trial booklet has produced operational problems because the postmark can easily be removed and the stamps reused due to a shiny paper being in the printing - current stocks are apparently being run down and we can probably expect a revised edition in due course. IN THE HOUSE OF LORDS IN 1973, LORD CLIFFORD OF CHUDLEIGH SUGGESTED THAT THE POST OFFICE SHOULD ENCOURAGE THE INTRODUCTION OF SELF-ADHESIVE STAMPS ON HEALTH GROUNDS

These original self-adhesives were the brainchild of two philatelic entrepreneurs - Mr Derek Worboys and Mr John Daynes who both submitted orders for these Machin octagonal diestamped designs to Her Majesty's Stationery Office to be produced on self-adhesive paper. These stamps were produced in late 1973 just prior to this special service being withdrawn. The 1st Series was duly issued on February 10th which was the exact date of the 10th Anniversary of the Sierra Leone self-adhesive Issue. These self-adhesives are officially approved by the Post Office and remain fully postally valid and are an important part of British postal history. We certainly recommend the new self-adhesive Booklet and, more especially, the interesting Combination Covers with the original 1974 1/2p of these there are three separate postmarks available - the 'Lickey End' tongue postmark was announced with very little advance notification and has proved very popular. (only 800 Covers in total were produced).

We now list the range of these very interesting self-adhesive stamps which are now available to include the 1st and 2nd Series by Derek Worboys and the 3rd Series by John Daynes. The 1st and 2nd Series appeared with square backing paper and the 3rd Series with circular backing paper for easy identification!
