These self-adhesive stamps were produced for the 'Act of Union' coin cover produced in conjunction with the Royal Mint, issued to mark the 300th Anniversary of the 'Act of Union' between England and Scotland. The cover was limited to 20,000 and they were used on cover and not on backing paper.
