Actually carried on board

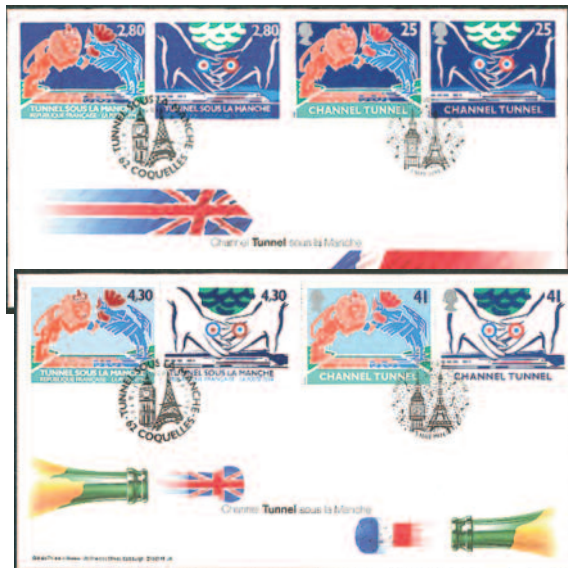


In 1983 Tom McLean attempted to sail in the smallest ever yacht 'Giltspur' from St Johns, Newfoundland to England – owing to bad weather he finished in Oporto, Portugal, covering the 3,360 miles in 62 days and 10 hours! Each cover as illustrated bears a Canadian stamp cancelled 9/6/83, and upon arrival on 9/8/83 a Portuguese stamp duly cancelled, together with various cachets 'Storm Delayed in Transit, etc. Each cover is personally autographed by Tom McLean, and includes an actual piece of cloth from the seven feet nine inch yacht's mainsail and is presented in a special descriptive presentation folder.
